1)Review/approve minutes from April 26th, 2019- Approved K. Bailey, 2nd L. Principio,, all in Favor-motion carried.

2) Dash Board-All four counties saw a lower unemployment rates in April compared to the March before with Seneca and Wayne Counties having almost a full percentage point (.9%) lower while Ontario and Yates both had .7% lower Rate than previous month.

3)OJT update-Group discussed new eligibility for Adult funded training (18 years of age, making less than \$25.00 an hour and in need of career services.) and the impact of new eligibility on OJTs. Group feels new policy will have a positive impact on number of OJTs. OJT’s that will serve more people and more companies. OJT upgrades will also assist in serving more companies.

4) Customized Training- Discussed development of Customized Training policy. Employees/trainees will need to meet Adult Eligibility and employers will need to be vetted. Policy will require matching funds and reimbursement will have a \$3,000.00 cap. Performance and Evaluation committee will need to review and full board will need to approve at next meeting in September before policy is implemented.
