1. **3/01/2018 Minutes** –Review and motion to approve- J. Lopez, Motion, 2nd by L. Haust - Approved unanimously.
2. **Dashboard**-February's unemployment rate was up a tenth of a percent for Yates County, down two tenths of a percent for Seneca County and stayed to same in Ontario and Wayne counties compared to the previous month of January. Four-county average for February was 4.5%, same as January, down 1.5% from the same month as last year.
February's Front Door Traffic saw about 200 fewer people than February of last program year resulting in fewer individuals receiving Self-Serve and Basic Career services. Individualized Services and Classroom Training service numbers were higher than last years while OJTs saw 8 fewer customers than same time last year.
3. **WIOA Primary Indicators**- Reviewed 2nd quarter report; Adult and Dislocated Worker employment rates for 2nd and 4th quarter were all above 100% of goal for reporting period. Placement in Employment, Education or Training rate for youth was 91.4% for 2nd quarter and 112.9% for 4th quarter. Median earnings for Adult and Dislocated workers were above 100% of goal. Credential rate for Adult was 51.7% and 36.4% for Dislocated Worker with no goal set for both measures. Youth Credential rate was 36.4% w/ no goal set. NYSDOL is collecting baseline info for measures w/ no goals including Business Services: Penetration Rate and Repeat Customer.
