 - FLCC-
 - i. C.N.A. classes continue
 1. Synchronized on-line

- **Dashboard report**-Unemployment rates for April were historically higher for all Finger Lakes counties Ontario-14.5, Seneca -15.2%, Wayne @ 14.3% and Yates county at 13.2%. The overall unemployment rate for the 4 county Finger Lakes region is at 14.2%, up from 5.1%. Across the state, the rate sits at 15%, slightly higher than the national rate of 14.4%. The unemployment rate is likely to climb higher in May. There was no front door traffic as the centers have been closed to the public. Website traffic numbers were not able to be gathered due to staff not being in the centers.
