- **Minutes reviewed June 6th, 2020** -Motion to approve: L. Haust, 2nd J. Wiese All in favor: yes.
- **Dashboard report**-Unemployment rates for May continued to have historically high rates for all Finger Lakes counties, But were lower than April highs: Ontario-10.1 (down 4.4% from April), Seneca -11.2%, 9Down 4% from April) Wayne @ 10.1% (down 4.2% from April) and Yates county at 8.9% (down 4.3%). The overall unemployment rate for the 4 county Finger Lakes region is at 10.1%, down from 14.2%. Across the state, the rate sits at 14.2%, slightly higher than the national rate of 13%. The unemployment rate is likely to climb higher in May. There was no front door traffic as the centers have been closed to the public.
- **No TAA Report**-No state wide call this month due to High volume of Initial UI claims and NYSDOL staff needing to serve those job-seekers. It was mentioned approval for TAA training has been slower then usual probably due to the same reason.
- **Opoïd/TET**-21 people have completed Peer Certification. 15 Are working. Tet program may be extended from 9/30/2020 to 12/30/2020. Waiting to hear from NYSDOL. Trainees have 90 days after training start to complete programs.
- **Virtual Workshops and Videos**-Ontario county has submitted Career-Center Intro for Hopewell center featuring L. Haust. It has been posted on website-
<https://fingerlakesworks.com/centers/> . Mangers will be asked if any other centers will be submitting. FLWIB is assembling a group of partners to develop virtual workshop focused on developing a Interviewing and Resume Writing workshops that can be posted on social media and taped.
- **Training Provider Offerings**- Group discussed local list of training providers and offerings currently listed on New York State Department of Labor's Eligible Training Provider List. (ETPL) List was reviewed and the following points were discussed:
 - Current list has many offerings with end dates that have past.
 - Current list is very limiting with choices only ranging from CDL to CNA to LPN...
 - Offerings listed don't represent the depth of current Demand Occupation List.
 - Cumbersome process for providers to maintain offering info and turnover at providers make it difficult to maintain list.

Group discussed FLWIB approval process and was asked to send offerings from outside the area for approval and addition to list. Group was asked to do the same for offerings that have trainees interested in attending. M. Woloson will review current list and follow up with providers to ask for timely updates for offerings.
