- **Minutes reviewed November 6, 2020** – A motion to approve the minutes was made by Ms. Haust and seconded by Ms. Smithers. All in favor, motion carried.
- **Dashboard report** - From September to October, unemployment rose in the region from 4.9% to 5.2%; NYS – 9.4% to 9.2%. Traffic to the career centers decreased, and remote contact is being captured for the purposes of adequate traffic numbers. Across the counties, 35 customers have utilized classroom training and 12 an OJT. Website traffic for the counties and the WIB decreased slightly from September to October.
- **Skill Up Finger Lakes** - Mr. Woloson reported that new numbers for SkillUp are not available at this time. As soon as they are, they will be shared with the group. The group then discussed the new offering from the Department of Labor, Coursera.
- **TAA Report** – Ms. Haust identified no changes.
- **Opioid/TET** – Jeff Weise has left the WIB and joined staff at FLACRA; Mr. Woloson is assisting in the transfer of active customers to career center staff. Both grants are scheduled to end December 31st and Mr. Woloson is following up regarding outcomes for those in temporary positions at FLACRA.
- **Virtual Workshops and Videos** - Ms. Haust reported that the recent virtual Career Navigator saw 7 customers register, with 6 completing the course. Pat Piles received great feedback for the virtual course offered virtually. The group discussed the low number of registrations, despite heavy marketing by all career centers.

Ms. Principio asked that the Performance and Evaluation Committee be made aware of the concern of career center staff about the lack of available training programs, such as CNA courses and Advanced Manufacturing Machinist. The lack of training is heavily impacting numbers for career center staff.
