- **Minutes reviewed September 4, 2020** – A motion to approve the minutes was made by Ms. Smithers and seconded by Ms. Haust. All in favor, motion carried.
- **Dashboard report** - From August to September, unemployment fell in the region from 8.2% to 4.9%; in the state from 12.6% to 9.4%. Traffic to the career centers has increased, partially due to the remote contact with customers being captured. Across the counties, 11 customers are in classroom training and 9 in an OJT. Website traffic for the counties and the WIB is rising.
- **Skill Up Finger Lakes** - Mr. Woloson broke down the number of registrants by Career Center and zip code, showing that the Wayne County Career Center had the most users register for Skill Up, but Geneva had the most registrations per zip code. Further, Mr. Woloson pointed out that the number of women registrants far outweigh the number of men (74% vs. 26%) and the highest number of registrants seem to be in the 46-60 year old range.
- **TAA Report** - No report available; statewide calls have been postponed due to COVID-19.
- **Opioid/TET** - The new Peer Mentor training available with FLACRA to be approved by the FLWIB on November 18<sup>th</sup>. Some of those who have previously completed the peer mentoring training are now enrolled in the CASAC training at Alfred State. \$30,000 in TET funds have been recaptured by the Department of Labor and redistributed to other areas due to underspending by the FLWIB. Jeff Weise has taken a position with FLACRA and will be leaving the FLWIB on November 27<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Woloson will be handling the transition of Opioid and TET customers to career center staff in December.
- **Virtual Workshops and Videos** -  
Job Search 101 webinar hosted by the FLWIB and presented by Amanda Lesterhuis and Petrea Ray, held on October 5<sup>th</sup>, was attended by 8 registrants.  
An interviewing webinar will be presented by Mary Gratton again in December and will be recorded and added to the WIB YouTube channel.  
An introductory video about Veterans' services available at the career centers will be recorded next week and also added to the YouTube channel.  
The Child Care Resources for Employers presentation was held on October 29<sup>th</sup> and was well attended, with 24 participants on the Zoom call. The recording is available on the YouTube channel.
