I. Introductions

II. WIOA Youth RFP PY'23

Ms. Badger has been working with FLWIB Youth Coordinator, LaToya Collins to update the last RFP that was released in February 2020 and does not allow for more extensions. After updates are completed, the RFP will go to the board for approval and be released to the public. Volunteers will be needed to review submissions. The timeline is not set in stone and FLWIB staff will meet internally to discuss final dates, but the subcommittee members will likely receive submissions March 25th and two weeks will be spent on review.

Ms. Parish (tentatively) and Mr. Edgar volunteered to serve on the subcommittee. Ms. Foote suggested college students for the subcommittee and Ms. Badger has others in mind.

III. WIOA Youth Program Performance

- a. 98 total youth are enrolled for PY'22: 22 in-school and 76 out-of-school youth.
- b. The PY'21 Primary Indicators of Performance are attached to these minutes.

The only area where our area did not fully meet or exceed the goal was in Measurable Skill Gains; earned 33.3%; goal 66%. This can be attributed to services not being completely entered into OSOS, such as Skills Progression reports from youth's employer not being entered into OSOS. Also, OSOS, despite recent upgrades (from Internet Explorer to Microsoft Edge), is not user friendly which could cause errors in reporting.

IV. "Finger Lakes Works...with their hands!"

FLWIB staff continues to work with partners regarding logistical and operational concerns of the larger event. This group will be informed of all updates when available.

V. Around the Room Updates

Ms. Badger added that while WIOA requires 11 contract elements for Adults and Dislocated Workers, the Youth contract requires 14 elements. A deeper discussion on this topic will come at a future meeting.
